- Below Owner pair with price will be auctioned during owner's meet.
- If more than 50% owner in "Owner meet" agree to the owner pair price, then that pair will be allocated to respective team
- If 50% owner do not agree then the pair will go for main auction

Auction Model



Bid Calculation:

Bid Particular	Redemption Point	
Total RP allotted for auction to each team	RP 5,00,000*	
Minimum Bid value for each pair	RP 20,000	
Minimum Bid value to be increased	RP 5,000	
Maximum Bid value for any pair = Total remaining amount – ((Remaining pairs to be bought – 1) x INR 20,000)		

^{*} If Owner pair is allotted to the team than that amount will be deducted from the total allotted fund of RP 5,00,000.



Auction Model



Auction Guideline:

- 1.) The decision of the auctioneer will be considered final
- 2.) Pairs once allotted by bid cannot be cancelled / withdrawn by team
- 3.) No exchange or selling of pairs is permissible once the bid for pair is closed till the completion of tournament
- 4.) If a pair is not bought by any team at the end of complete auction process then they will be allotted to the teams through a lucky draw.
- 5.) All team will have to buy 6 pairs consisting of 1 Women's pair and 5 Men's pair



RBL Season 4



- Team Owner / Auction Model

- > Each team will have 6 pairs 1 Women pair & 5 Male pair
- > 16 teams will be divided in 4 groups. So each group will have 4 teams
- All teams in each group will play against the other teams in their group
- 12 teams will proceed to knock out stage
- Each team will have to play 3 ties during league stage.
- Total 5 games have to be played in each tie.
- Each pair must play minimum 2 games in the 3 ties during day 1 league stage.
- Each match during group league stage & Knock out will be played for 30 points. 30th Point will be golden point.





- After the league stage, top 3 teams from each group will qualify for knock out stage, they will play the pre-quarter, quarter finals, semifinals & finals.
- Each tie will have 5 matches which will be played in below sequence :-

Sr. no	Match	Point	Description
1	WD	2	Women's doubles
2	MD 1	2	Men's doubles
3	MD 2 (ICON)	3 (+1*)	Icon Pair Match
4	MD 3	2	Men's doubles
5	MD 4	2	Men's doubles





WD Match	1st match will be women's doubles game. Challenger game	
	cannot be taken on WD Match	

The winner of ICON match will get 3 points. Twister: if the difference of game point is 20 points, then the winning team will get 1 bonus point for winning ICON match. Example: a.) If team A wins the game against B with the score of 30 – 11 then Team A gets 3 points b.) If the team A wins the game against B with the score of 30 – 10 then Team A gets 4 points





Challenger Match

One of the match has to be designated as Challenger match in the tie slip before exchanging the tie slip.

Twister:

- 1.) The challenger match cannot be taken on ICON and WD match.
- 2.) When a match is designated as Challenger match then there is 1 bonus point assigned to that match. The team winning the challenger match will get 1 additional point in that game.
- 2.) In case if both teams have assigned the same match as Challenger match, then it will be treated as ICON match and ICON match rule applies

At the end of each tie, the team which would have scored more total game points of 5 games will get 1 reward point.

In case if both the teams have scored same points then in such case both teams will get 0 reward point.

Example:

- 1.) If the total of 5 game points for Team A is 115 and Team B is 122 then Team B will get 1 bonus point
- 2.) If the total of 5 game points for Team A is 120 and Team B is 120 then both teams will get 0 point



RBL Season 4

- 1.) All players have to be registered in Pairs only. Age cut off for players is born in or before 1995.
- 2.) Players are not allowed to change the pair throughout the tournament after Auction.
- 3.) In case due to unforeseen event, if a player cannot participate in the tournament after the auction but before the tournament date then the team captain / owner has to inform RBL committee before 31st Jan' 2025 and can choose from below option –
- a) Replacement of Pair / Player: Appropriate new pair / player will be allocated by the RBL committee from the reserve pool.
- b) Continue with existing player: The available player from the pair will continue to play and his partner from the remaining team players will be nominated by the opposite team captain.





4a.) If a male player is declared unavailable before the exchange of tie slips of the match, then rule 3b will be applicable for only 1 missing player. If the declaration of missing player is not done before the exchange of tie slip then the game has to be forfeited. Only 1 missing player replacement is allowed.

4b.) If the player gets injured during the match, then that game has to be forfeited at the score when the injury occured. Eg:- 30-12 (injury occurred at the score of 12.

4c.) If the injury occurs on Day 1 and the pair has not played the required min. 2 games / pair, then the replacement will be provided as per 3b. But in case if the injured player was already playing with a replacement player, then the next game has to be forfeited.

4d.) If the team is already playing with replacement player as per 3b and if the player from other pair of the team gets injured then the team is allowed to play with any one player who has a missing partner. Both pair with missing partner cannot play the tie.





4e.) If a female player is not available on the day of tournament and replacement of player / pair from reserve pool is not possible then the match will be forfeited, and the score will be reported as 21-0.

4f.) If the female player is injured during the match and could not play the next tie then the next tie game will be forfeited with the score of 21-0.

Note:

- a) The injured player or missing player cannot play the rest of the tournament if he has opted for replacement in 1 match.
- b) Female player will be allowed to play after injury or missing the game





General Rules:

- Allocation of players to the teams will be done through an Auction process. Players once purchased cannot be resold / exchanged with other teams.
- Each team will consist of total 5 MD pairs and 1 WD pair.
- Total 16 teams will be divided in 4 groups. Each group will consist of 4 teams.
- > Groups will be formed through luck draw system.





- During group league stage, if there is a tie then the winner will be decided based on the result of the tie played between those two teams during group stage. The winner of the tie in terms of points will be ranked higher in group. If there is a tie, then the team which would have won more games during the tie will be declared winner and ranked higher.
- If there is a tie during knock out stage, then the team which would have won more games during the tie will be declared winner.
- The no.1 ranked team of each group will directly enter the quarter final stage while the team ranked 2nd & 3rd in each group will have to play pre-quarter final against similar ranked team.





- The winner of the pre-quarterfinal final will enter the quarterfinal and play against the team which has directly qualified in the quarterfinals. Subsequently the winners will play semi-finals & finals.
- Forfeit of match: The matches will be forfeited under below condition
 - a) If the player gets injured during the match, then the match has to be forfeited and the opposite team will be declared winner. The game points will be full points actual game point (eg:- 30 12).
 - b) If the player does not report on time as per schedule, then the match has to be forfeited and the opposite team will be declared winner. The game points will be full points -0 game point (eg:- 30 0).





- Time management: Players must report for their match on announcement within max 5 mins else the match will be considered to be forfeited with the score of 30-0. In case if players of both the teams does not report then the match will be considered as forfeited and none of the team will be allocated any points and the score will be considered as 0-0 game points. Time breaks during match will be as per BWF Badminton rules.
- Slips for Sequence of Play to be exchanged by the Captain before the start of tie.
 Tie slip will be exchanged in front of tie referee.
- Sequence of play is predetermined as per the format of the slip and each match has to be played in the same sequence. In case due to any circumstances, if the team wants to change the sequence then it is only permissible if both the captains agree to it. In case if the captain does not agree then that match has to be forfeited.





- Under no circumstances, teams will be allowed to delay the match after the completion of all the remaining matches in the tie. So, all matches have to be completed within the stipulated time of the tie and cannot be postponed to another time during the day / tournament
- Referee's decision is to be considered as Final Decision. Referee's decision has to be honored and no disputes will be entertained on the decision.
- Organizing committee reserves the right to disqualify any pair / team in case of any malpractice or misconduct reported.





- Committee reserves the right to take the final decision on any concerns /disputes on regulations. Committee reserves the right to change the regulation without prior notice but will definitely deliberate with the key stakeholders like owners etc.
- From owner's will have to appoint 1 player as Team Captain. Team owner can also nominate himself as Captain.
- In case of any dispute between captain & owner, owner will have the right to over-rule captain's decision.
- > Team captain will be the single point of contact for any communication. Team players will communicate through captain only.
